Whereas, A partner agency of the United Way of Chester County, the West Chester Area Day Care Center is a nonprofit childcare center that provides a quality, early childhood education program that promotes the development of children socially, emotionally, intellectually and physically in a safe and nurturing environment. The facility opened in 1962 with five students and three teachers and moved to its current location on Niels Street in 1969. A Star 3 center through the Keystone Stars Program, the West Chester Area Day Care Center serves children from the age of six weeks through kindergarten on a year-round basis and children through age twelve before and after school and full-time during the summers. The center has grown to include seventeen full-time teachers, three administrators and twenty-one part-time staff members who serve an enrollment of more than one hundred children.
